23.2 The first boat sailed by a helm (and crew as appropriate) primarily resident in Ireland and full annual member of the Irish RS Class Association in the RS400 and RS200 Traveller Series fleet will be awarded the title Irish RS400/RS200 Traveller Series Champions.
